

2022 MARKET DATA


2022 was a strong year for New Mexico's farmers' markets, farm stands, mobile markets, CSAs, and grocery stores. While some normalcy to life returned, COVID-19 pandemic and related economic challenges persisted.


In spite of these challenges, the data shows ongoing robust consumer commitment to purchasing local food and supporting our local economy, including farmers and ranchers.

Gross total sales in 2022 were 43% higher than pre-pandemic annual averages and just slightly lower (5%) than 2021 totals.

SNAP and Double Up Food Bucks contributed nearly \$2.3M to the local food economy during 2022. The Double Up incentive program continues to be critical for shoppers experiencing significant need due to ongoing economic hardship.

The FreshRx produce prescription program added nearly \$200,000 to the state's local food sales in 2022. In the coming years, FreshRx will continue to contribute more to New Mexico's local food economy, and improve the health of at-risk New Mexicans.
