- Attend NMFMA Tier 1 and Tier 2 Trainings; OR
- Attend a Produce Safety Alliance (PSA) Training; OR
- Have a 3rd Party Audit

Support is Available for All Farmers!

- Food safety training is \$25 or less!
- Technical assistance is available every step of the way
- Your Risk Assessment is reviewed by a local team
- A Certificate of Compliance is issued upon approval
- Once approved, a full application is only due every 3 years
